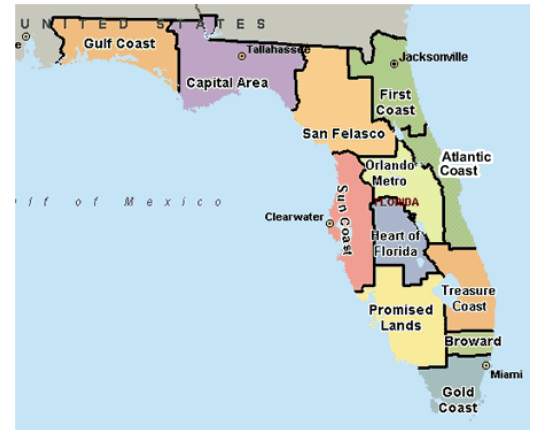
Volunteer... Opportunities exist at the State and local levels to get involved in the advancement of the organization.
